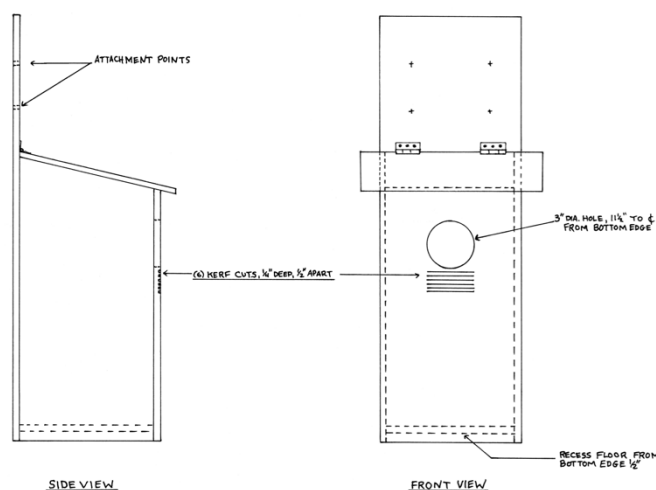
# Workshop: How to Build a Screech-Owl Nest Box

## About the Screech-Owl:

Screech-Owls are relatively widespread and common but, in some areas including Lasqueti Island, their population has declined because of habitat loss. Few have been spotted on the island in recent years. Both Barred Owls and Great Horned Owl Prey on the much smaller Screech-Owls. If given a chance at nesting, their small size, excellent camouflage, and varied diet make Screech-Owl's successful survivors.
